

Kansas Wildlife Exhibit

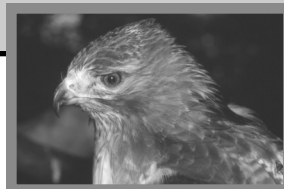

Located in Central Riverside Park at 700 Nims, the Kansas Wildlife Exhibit contains eight enclosures with over 25 different species of native mammals, reptiles and birds.

The cages have a modern, naturalistic design which requires the visitor to look carefully in order to see the inhabitants. Opened in 1988, the Kansas Wildlife Exhibit continues a long tradition of zoos on this site since 1901.

Many of the animals kept at the Kansas Wildlife Exhibit are used in environmental education programs conducted by the staff at the Great Plains Nature Center. Through these programs thousands of children and adults, who might otherwise never get the chance, have seen these Kansas animals up close.

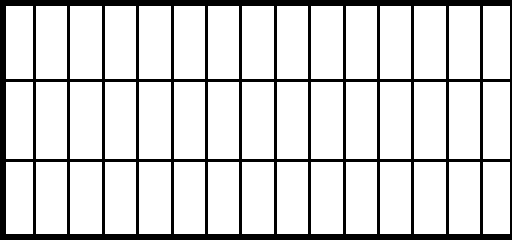

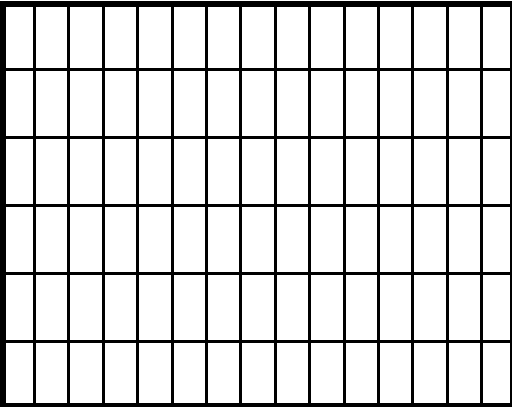

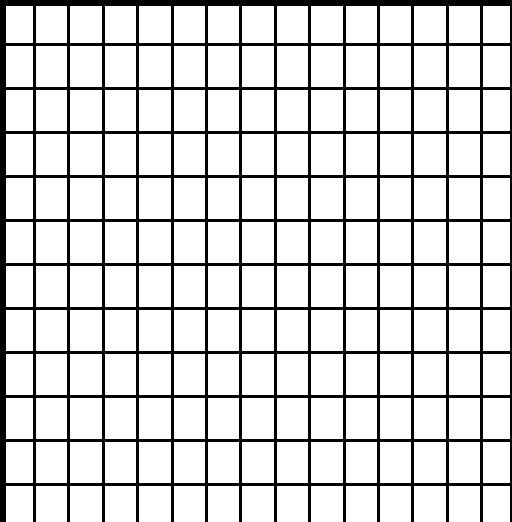
